





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon in Kitaotao, Bukidnon

as of 19 January 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 10 September 2023 by the PAGASA, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by the Southwest Monsoon brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Zamboanga Peninsula, BARMM, SOCCSKSARGEN, Misamis Occidental, Lanao del Norte and Bukidnon.

On the same day at around 5:00 PM, Sitio Misalay, Brgy. Digongan, Kitaotao, Bukidnon experienced a landslide incident due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the Southwest Monsoon.

On 13 September 2023, Brgy. Sinuda, Tawas, and Kipilas of the same LGU reported a flooding incident caused by continuous heavy rainfall brought by the prevailing Southwest Monsoon.

Local authorities and disaster management teams of Kitaotao, Bukidnon, actively engaged in the response operation to address the displacement concerns caused by the effects of Southwest Monsoon.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 105 families or 537 persons are affected in four (4) barangays in Kitaotao, Bukidnon (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

Six (6) families or 30 persons are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **59 houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **53** are **partially damaged** in **Kitaotao**, **Bukidnon** (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P8,250.00** worth of assistance from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** was provided to the affected families. (see Annex D).
