# I. Situation Overview

On 02 December 2023 at around 6:15 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Pakigne, Minglanilla, Cebu. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) responded and declared the fire out at 6:58 PM.

A total of two (2) families or eight (8) persons are affected in Brgy. Pakigne, Minglanilla, Cebu (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **two (2) families** or **eight (8) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Pakigne, Minglanilla, Cebu** (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱19,326.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱17,326.00 from DSWD and ₱2,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
