
DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 1, Bantay, Ilocos Sur as of 23 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 January 2024 at around 10PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 1, Bantay, Ilocos Sur. The fire was declared out at around 10:14 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **nine (9) families** or **30 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 1, Bantay, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** of **Brgy. 1, Bantay, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **five (5) persons** or **18 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **six (6) families** or **23 persons** displaced in **Brgy. 1, Bantay, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **three (3) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 1, Bantay, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,190.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱6,390.00** from **DSWD** and **₱1,800.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
