

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 1, Lucena City, Quezon as of 26 January 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 January 2024 at around 4:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy.1, Lucena City, Quezon. The fire was declared out at around 6:15 AM.

A total of **23 families** or **80 persons** are affected in **Brgy.1, Lucena City, Quezon** (see Annex A).

There are **23 families** or **80 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **19 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy.1, Lucena City, Quezon** (see Annex C).
