

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 262, Tondo, Manila as of 12 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 January 2024 at around 3:50 PM, a fire incident occurred at No. 1314 Mayhaligue St., Cor. Masangkay St., Brgy. 262, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4:28 PM.

A total of **46 families** or **160 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 262, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

A total of **25 houses** were damaged; of which, **24** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 262, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).
