I. Situation Overview

On 17 March 2024 at around 4:48 AM, a fire incident occurred at the streets of Joaquin, Bautista, and Mariategue in Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City. The fire was declared out at around 9:42 AM.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 91,111 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 86,642 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 4,469 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 32,896 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱432.79 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
