

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City as of 17 March 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 March 2024 at around 4:48 AM, a fire incident occurred at the streets of Joaquin, Bautista, and Mariategue in Brgy. Alabang, Muntinlupa City. The fire was declared out at around 9:42 AM.
