I. Situation Overview

On 28 January 2024 at around 11:03 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bacayan, Cebu City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 11:43 AM.

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **13 families** or **45 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Bacayan Elementary School** in **Brgy. Bacayan, Cebu City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

A total of **12 houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **six (6)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Bacayan, Cebu City, Cebu** (see Annex C).
