

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal as of 18 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 January 2024 at around 2PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal. The fire was declared out at around 3:30 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **83 families** or **392 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **83 families** or **392 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Donya Pepeng Covered Court** in **Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **25 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Banaba, San Mateo, Rizal** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱102,700.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱61,200.00** from **DSWD** and **₱41,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
