





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City

as of 07 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2024 at around 11:33 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kanipaan, Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City. The fire was declared out on 07 January at around 3:55 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **104 families** or **493 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Basak Pardo**, **Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 104 families or 493 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 95 houses were damaged; of which, 90 are totally damaged and five (5) are partially damaged in Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City (see Annex C).

07 January 2024	DSWD FO VII City/Municipality Action Team (C/MAT) together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cebu City through its Department of Social Welfare Services (DSWS) administered the profiling and validation of the affected families and individuals through the use of Family Access Card in Emergencies and Disasters (FACED).

c. Other Activities

07 January 2024	 DSWD FO VII maintains close coordination with all concerned offices for significant disaster updates and any augmentation request. DSWD FO VII spearheaded by Assistant Regional Director for Administration (ARDA), Tonyson Luther Lee, together with the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) Chief and the C/MAT visited the identified evacuation centers to assess the needs of the displaced families and individuals.
06 January 2024	 DSWD FO VII through its DRMD alerted its Quick Response Team (QRT) and coordinated with the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and the City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (CDRRMO) of the LGU of Cebu City for further information on the fire incident. DSWD FO VII ensured the availability of FNIs for possible relief augmentation to the LGU of Cebu City.
