## I. Situation Overview

On 03 January 2024 at around 3:48 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Biasong, Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 4:15 PM.

A total of nine (9) families or 45 persons are affected in Brgy. Biasong, Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte (see Annex A).

There are **nine** (9) families or 45 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of four (4) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Biasong, Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P55,561.50** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
