as of 12 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 January 2024 at around 5:00PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Balatogan, Brgy. Buenavista, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 6:33 PM.

One (1) family or 11 persons are affected in Brgy. Buenavista, Himalayan City, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

One (1) family or 11 persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends in Brgy. Buenavista, Himalayan City, Negros Occidental (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Buenavista, Himalayan City, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P8,496.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
