



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Calumpang, General Santos City

as of 02 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 December 2023 at around 3:30 PM, a fire incident transpired at Purok Crisostomo, Brgy. Calumpang, General Santos City causing displacement to ten (10) families or 48 individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **13 families** or **65 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Calumpang, General Santos City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **ten (10) families** or **48 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **13 houses** were damaged; of which, **ten (10)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Calumpang, General Santos City** (see Annex C).
