

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Canelar, Zamboanga City

as of 31 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 December 2023 at around 4:13 AM, a fire incident occurred at Mayor Jaldon St., Brgy. Canelar, Zamboanga City. The fire was declared out at around 5:30 AM.

In response, the DSWD's Field Office in Region IX promptly provided relief assistance to meet the immediate needs of affected families and individuals. Consequently, affected families are currently residing with their relatives, resulting in the non-activation of evacuation centers.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **11 families** or **23 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Canelar, Zamboanga City** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of **11 houses** were damaged; of which, **seven (7)** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Canelar, Zamboanga City** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱22,181.50** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families. (see Annex C).
