

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City as of 07 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2024 at around 9:23 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kalapukan, Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 10:48 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **200 families** or **600 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **200 families** or **600 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Carreta Elementary School** in **Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **66 houses** were damaged; of which, **60** are **totally damaged** and **six (6)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City** (see Annex C).
