I. Situation Overview

On 21 January 2024 at around 2:10 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. District 1 (Poblacion), Sibalom, Antique. The fire was declared out at around 3:13 PM.

A total of **two (2) families** or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. District 1 (Poblacion), Sibalom, Antique** (see Annex A).

There are **two (2) families** or **five (5) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. District 1 (Poblacion), Sibalom, Antique** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱11,731.56** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
