I. Situation Overview

On 02 January 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Guiljungan, Cauayan, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 2:53 PM.

One (1) family or six (6) persons are affected in Brgy. Guiljungan, Cauayan, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or six (6) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Guiljungan, Cauayan, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P5,605.50** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family. (see Annex D).
