I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2024 at around 7:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Burgos St., Brgy. IV, Dagupan City, Pangasinan.

A total of **10 families** or **48 persons** are affected in **Brgy. IV, Dagupan City, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **48 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10 houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. IV, Dagupan City, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱21,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
