I. Situation Overview

On 18 January 2024 at around 12:10 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Igdalaguit, Sibalom, Antique. The fire was declared out at around 1:13 AM.

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Igdalaguit, Sibalom, Antique (see Annex C).
