I. Situation Overview

On 08 January 2024 at around 10:20 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Luyang, Sibalom, Antique. The fire was declared out at around 11:43 PM.

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Luyang, Sibalom, Antique (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱5,865.78 worth of assistance was provided by the DSWD to the affected family (see Annex D).
