

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Malangsa, Vallehermoso, Negros Oriental

as of 09 January 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 December 2023 at around 6:55 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Malangsa, Vallehermoso, Negros Oriental. The fire burned a house made of light materials affecting a family of four (4). The fire was declared out at around 7:25 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **one (1) family** or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Malangsa, Vallehermoso, Negros Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

A. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Malangsa, Vallehermoso, Negros Oriental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱12,966.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱7,966.00** from **DSWD** and **₱5,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
