





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Malangsa, Vallehermoso, Negros Oriental

as of 09 January 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 December 2023 at around 6:55 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Malangsa, Vallehermoso, Negros Oriental. The fire burned a house made of light materials affecting a family of four (4). The fire was declared out at around 7:25 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **one (1) family** or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Malangsa**, **Vallehermoso**, **Negros Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

A. Outside Evacuation Center
One (1) family or four (4) persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Malangsa, Vallehermoso, Negros Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱12,966.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, ₱7,966.00 from DSWD and ₱5,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
