#### I. Situation Overview

On 31 December 2023 at around 12:43 PM, a fire incident occurred at San Francisco, Brgy. Matina Crossing, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 2:44 PM.

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 42 families or 236 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the San Francisco De Asis Basketball Court, Brgy. Matina Crossing, Davao City (see Annex B).

A total of 18 houses were damaged; of which, 13 are totally damaged and five (5) are partially damaged (see Annex C).
