





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Nato, La Castellana, Negros Occidental

as of 27 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 January 2024 at around 11:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Nato, La Castellana, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 12:54 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. Nato, La Castellana, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or five (5) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Nato, La Castellana, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}10,307.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}5,307.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}5,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
