

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Nato, La Castellana, Negros Occidental

as of 27 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 January 2024 at around 11:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Nato, La Castellana, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 12:54 PM.

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Nato, La Castellana, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Nato, La Castellana, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,307.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱5,307.00** from **DSWD** and **₱5,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
