





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Sibonga, Cebu

as of 17 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 December 2023 at around 2:20 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, Sibonga, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 5:30 AM.

One (1) family or two (2) persons are affected in Brgy. Poblacion, Sibonga, Cebu (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or two (2) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Sibonga, Cebu (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P14,229.90** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **P9,929.90** from **DSWD** and **P4,300.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
