I. Situation Overview

On 14 January 2024 at around 1:46 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Tanjay City, Negros Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 2:10 PM.

A total of **four (4) families** or **15 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Tanjay City, Negros Oriental** (see Annex A).

There are **four (4) families** or **15 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of four (4) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Tanjay City, Negros Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}4,144.00\$ worth of assistance was provided by \$\mathbb{DSWD}\$ to the affected families (see Annex D).
