

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

as of 18 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 January 2024 at around 4:45 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. The fire was declared out at around 6:00 AM.

A total of **16 families** or **47 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **16 families** or **47 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** of **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **13 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex C).
