## I. Situation Overview

On 17 January 2024 at around 4:45 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. The fire was declared out at around 6:00 AM.

A total of 13 houses were damaged; of which, 10 are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex C).
