
DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Solong, Sibalom, Antique as of 16 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 January 2024 at around 12:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Solong, Sibalom, Antique. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of fire was allegedly due to a faulty electrical wire. The fire was declared out at around 1:43 PM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

One house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Solong, Sibalom, Antique** (see Annex C).
