





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City

as of 24 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 January 2024 at around 1:41 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) – Bacolod City, the fire caused was due to faulty electrical wirings and it was declared fire out at around 2:35 PM.
