





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tabu, Ilog, Negros Occidental

as of 09 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 January 2024 at around 3PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tabu, Ilog, Negros Occidental. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) – Ilog the fire cause was due to faulty electrical wirings and it was declared fire out at around 4:15 PM.

One (1) family or six (6) persons are affected in Brgy. Tabu, Ilog, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or six (6) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Tabu, Ilog, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P8,615.78** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
