



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tagukon, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental

as of 09 January 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 January 2024 at around 2:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Tagukon, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the fire was allegedly cause by electrical faulty wiring. The fire was declared out at around 3:35 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of one (1) family or nine (9) persons are affected in Brgy. Tagukon, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

A. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **nine (9) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Tagukon, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱6,947.78 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, ₱4,447.78 from DSWD and ₱2,500.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
