I. Situation Overview

On 09 January 2024 at around 12:05 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tampalon, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 1:10 AM.

A total of **₱6,947.78** worth of assistance was provided to the affected person; of which, **₱4,447.78** from **DSWD** and **₱2,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
