I. Situation Overview

On 15 January 2024 at around 12:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Vilvar, San Remegio, Antique. The fire was declared out at around 1:43 PM.

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or two (2) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Vilvar, San Remigio, Antique (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P5**,865.78 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
