





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Vito, Minglanilla, Cebu

as of 17 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 December 2023 at around 2:45 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Vito Minglanilla, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 2:58 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. Vito Minglanilla, Cebu (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or five (5) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Vito Minglanilla, Cebu (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}10,051.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}8,551.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}1,500.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
