

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Yulo Drive, Iloilo City as of 18 January 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 15 January 2024 at around 12:23 PM, a fire incident occurred at Phase 1, Villa Carolina, Brgy. Yulo Drive, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 1:12 PM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI together with the LGU of Iloilo City, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **seven (7) families** or **32 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Yulo Drive, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **seven (7) families** or **32 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Yulo Drive Covered Gym** in **Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Yulo Drive, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱89,461.40** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱45,934.00** from **DSWD** and **₱43,527.40** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
