



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Bulusan, Sorsogon

as of 31 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 December 2023 at around 6:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 4, Sitio Tongod, Bulusan, Sorsogon. Based on the report submitted by the DRMD Field Office V a residential house owned by a Pantawid Beneficiary was engulfed in flames during the incident.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region V provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family. Currently, the affected family is residing temporarily with their relatives.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Bulusan, Sorsogon** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Bulusan, Sorsogon. (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱4,258.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
