

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Butuan City

as of 29 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 January 2024 at around 5:42 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Alugbati, Brgy. Golden Ribbon, Butuan City that also affected the nearby Brgy. Maon also in Butuan City. The fire was declared out at around 6:23 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **30 families** or **105 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Butuan City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **30 families** or **105 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **30 houses** were damaged; of which, **23** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Butuan City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱30,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
