

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Mandaue City, Cebu as of 26 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 January 2025, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Looc and Brgy. Opao in Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 7:33 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **127 families** or **543 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **127 families** or **543 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **112 houses** were damaged; of which, **111** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex C).
