

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood and Landslide Incidents due to ITCZ in Kitaotao, Bukidnon

as of 19 January 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

Issued on 18 June 2023 at around 5:00 PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day, several barangays in the municipality of Kitaotao, Bukidnon experienced flash flood and landslide due to ITCZ that resulted in the displacement of affected families and individuals.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **67 families** or **335 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Kitaotao, Bukidnon** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **nine (9) families** or **45 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Kitaotao, Bukidnon** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱14,500.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
