





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood and Landslide Incidents in Brgy. White Kulaman, Kitaotao, Bukidnon

as of 19 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 02 June 2023 at 4:00AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms brought by the Southwest Monsoon is prevalent over the rest of the country and may cause possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On 04 June 2023, a flashflood and landslide incident were reported in Brgy. White Kulaman, Kitaotao, Bukidnon, due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the Southwest Monsoon.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 44 families or 220 persons were affected in Brgy. White Kulaman, Kitaotao, Bukidnon (see Annex A).
