





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Tension Cracks in Brgy. Cantao-an, City of Naga, Cebu

as of 14 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 September 2023, tension cracks were observed in the proximity of Purok Riverside, Brgy. Cantao-an in the City of Naga, Cebu. On 04 October 2023, the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) reported that several families were evacuated to Cantao-an Elementary School.

On 13 January 2024, the City of Naga through its CSWDO reported additional number of affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 2,121 families or 7,716 persons are affected in Brgy. Cantao-an in the City of Naga, Cebu (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 61 families or 232 persons currently taking temporary shelter in one (1) evacuation center in Brgy. Cantao-an in the City of Naga, Cebu (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **2,060 families** or **7,484 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 2,121 families or 7,716 persons displaced in in Brgy. Cantao-an in the City of Naga, Cebu (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **90 houses** were damaged; of which, **13** are **totally damaged** and **77** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Cantao-an in the City of Naga, Cebu** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}4,777,154.70\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}1,225,584.70\$ from DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}3,201,570.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and \$\mathbb{P}350,000.00\$ from other partners. (see Annex F).
