

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Tension Cracks in Brgy. Cantao-an, City of Naga, Cebu as of 14 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 September 2023, tension cracks were observed in the proximity of Purok Riverside, Brgy. Cantao-an in the City of Naga, Cebu. On 04 October 2023, the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) reported that several families were evacuated to Cantao-an Elementary School.

On 13 January 2024, the City of Naga through its CSWDO reported additional number of affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,121 families** or **7,716 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cantao-an in the City of Naga, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **61 families** or **232 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Cantao-an in the City of Naga, Cebu** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **2,060 families** or **7,484 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **2,121 families** or **7,716 persons** displaced in in **Brgy. Cantao-an in the City of Naga, Cebu** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **90 houses** were damaged; of which, **13** are **totally damaged** and **77** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Cantao-an in the City of Naga, Cebu** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱4,777,154.70** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱1,225,584.70** from **DSWD**, **₱3,201,570.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, and **₱350,000.00** from **other partners**. (see Annex F).
