

DSWD DROMIC Report #13 on the Effects of Shear Line

as of 09 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 December 2024, several municipalities in the provinces of Capiz and Aklan in Western Visayas and municipalities in the provinces of Albay, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur, and Catanduanes in Bicol Region experienced incidents of flooding and landslides due to the effects of Shear Line.


On 02 December 2024, flooding, landslides, and other incidents related to the effects of Shear Line were reported in Cebu City.

On 04 December 2024, the effects of Shear Line were also reported in Tuguegarao City, Cagayan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **57,171 families** or **240,483 persons** are affected in **434 barangays** in **Regions II, V, VI** and **VII** (see Annex A).





III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 12 families or 56 persons currently taking temporary shelter in four (4) evacuation centers in Regions VI (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **13 families** or **60 persons** still displaced in **Regions VI** and **VII** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **49 houses** were damaged; of which, **13** are **totally damaged** and **36** are **partially damaged** in **Regions V**, **VII** and **VII** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\$,406,426.84 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}\$8,362,926.84 from \$\mathbb{D}\$SWD and \$\mathbb{P}\$1,043,500.00 from the Local Government Units (LGUs) (see Annex F).

- ₱3.30 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
