

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Nunangan, Datu Anggal Midtimbang, Maguindanao del Sur as of 31 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 January 2024 at around 9AM, an armed conflict involving two warring commanders of 104th Base Command of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) transpired in Brgy. Nunangan, Datu Anggal Midtimbang, Maguindanao del Sur, which resulted in the displacement of families and persons in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **710 families** or **3,550 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Datu Anggal Midtimbang, Maguindanao del Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **710 families** or **3,550 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱464,340.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
