

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Shear Line as of 17 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 January 2024 at 4PM, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by the Shear Line might have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Eastern Visayas, Central Visayas, Caraga, and Northern Mindanao.

On 15 January 2024, the Shear Line continuously affected Caraga, while Davao Region experienced its effects the next day.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **56,917 families** or **224,720 persons** are affected in **145 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **3,633 families** or **12,963 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **63 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **618 families** or **2,530 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **4,251 families** or **15,493 persons** displaced in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Region XI** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱3,345,708.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱3,202,008.00** from **DSWD** and **₱143,700.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
