

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City as of 08 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2024 at around 11:33 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kanipaan, Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City. The fire was declared out on 07 January at around 3:55 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **144 families** or **636 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **144 families** or **636 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **100 houses** were damaged; of which, **92** are **totally damaged** and **eight (8)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱367,496.75** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families, of which **₱55,496.75** from **DSWD** and **₱312,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
