





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City

as of 08 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2024 at around 9:23 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kalapukan, Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 10:48 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 170 families or 633 persons are affected in Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 170 families or 633 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Carreta Elementary School in Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **102 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Carreta**, **Cebu City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱410,253.25 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱50,253.25 from DSWD and ₱360,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).

07 January 2024	DSWD FO VII maintains close monitoring and coordination with all concerned offices for significant disaster updates and any augmentation request.
06 January 2024	 DSWD FO VII through the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) alerted the DSWD FO VII Quick Response Team (QRT) to take swift action and secure its premises from potential fire impact. DSWD FO VII spearheaded by Assistant Regional Director for Administration (ARDA) Tonyson Luther Lee visited and checked the DSWD FO and coordinated with the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and the City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (CDRRMO). DSWD FO VII led by ARDA Lee together with the DRMD Chief and the FOs Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM) coordinator visited the identified EC to assess the needs and ensure the welfare of the fire-affected families as well as provide assistance in the management of the camp/s.
