



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lagao, General Santos City

as of 02 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 January 2024 at around 10AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 13-Carcon Village, Brgy. Lagao, General Santos City.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XII provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **23 families** or **90 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lagao, General Santos City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **23 families** or **90 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Carcon Village Multipurpose Hall** in **Brgy. Lagao, General Santos City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 23 houses were damaged; of which, 19 are totally damaged and four (4) are partially damaged in Brgy. Lagao, General Santos City (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱142,899.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).

- 68,129 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱693.97 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
